Profile of Investment Managers

Fund Performance Review

NIT Income Fund posted an annualized return of 10.56% p.a. during the month of March compared to its benchmark return of 8.16% p.a., thus outperforming its benchmark by 2.4%. The YTD return for FY15 stood at 15.85% p.a. against the benchmark return of 9.58% p.a., an outperformance by 6.27%.

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of March clocked in at 2.5% from 3.24% year on year over the previous month. Overall inflation for the period July-March 2015 stood at 5.1%.

State Bank of Pakistan announced its Monetary Policy during the month and cut Dicount Rates by 50bps from 8.50% to 8.00%. SBP has continued with monetary easing due to improvement on the inflationary front with monthly CPI now down to 2.5% in Mar-15, along with rising reserves and curtailed current deficit.


At the end of the month, NIT IF had an exposure of around 7% of its total assets in TFCs, about 62% in PIBs and 22% in T-bills, whereas the remaining was in the form of cash and other assets. Overall weighted average maturity of the portfolio stood at 669 days at the end of March.
