### Objective of the fund

The objective of NIT Income Fund is to generate competitive stream of return with moderate level of risk for its unit holders, by investing primarily in fixed income securities/instruments.

### Profile of Investment Managers

National Investment Trust Ltd. (NITL) is the first and the largest Asset Management Company of Pakistan, formed in 1962. With approximately Rs. 99 billion assets under management as on 31 October 2016, the family of Funds of NIT comprises of ten funds including 4 equity funds, 2 fixed income funds, 1 money market fund, 1 islamic income fund, 1 conventional pension fund and 1 islamic pension fund. Further to cater to the matters relating to investments in NITL managed Funds and day to day inquiries/issues of their unit holders, a state of the art Investors' Facilitation Centre is also in place. The Board of Directors of NITL consists of representatives of leading financial institutions, prominent industrialists and a nominee of Govt. of Pakistan. The Company has been assigned an Asset Manager rating of "AM24" by PACRA, which reflects the company's high investment management industry standards and benchmarks with noted strengths in several of the rating factors. All Investment decisions are taken by the Investment Committee of NITL.


#### Fund Performance Review

NIT Income Fund posted a YTD annualized return for FY17 of 4.52% p.a. against the benchmark return of 6.04% p.a. The Fund posted an annualized return of 5.22% p.a for the month of October while its benchmark return was 6.05% p.a.

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of October stood at 4.2% increasing from 3.9% over the previous month. The average 4 months CPI inflation now stands at 3.95% compared to 1.65% in 4 months FY16.


Asset allocation of NIT IF by the end of month reveals that NIT IF had exposure of approximately 10% of its total assets in TFCs, about 4% in PIBs, 42% in Treasury bills and around 4% in MTS whereas the remaining was in the form of cash and other assets. At the end of the month, weighted average time to maturity of the portfolio stood at 276 days.
